

Zach & Carrie Wolfe Pioneers/Warren Jail Ministry

God is continuing to work in the prison here in Warren. Just last week 3 women surren-

dered their lives to the Lord! In addition, several other women who have been Christians nominally, are going deeper in their relationship with Jesus than ever before.

I'm grateful for all the volunteers and local churches throughout Warren County who makes this ministry possible. I'm thankful for Calvary Baptist and your support of the ministry, and Scott Swanson who has become a faithful contributor to the ministry by helping lead a men's Bible study and filling in for me from time to time on Sundays.

In the last 6 months I've been reminded of the spiritual battle that we are in as several inmates have requested Tarot Cards. Most of the prisoners have struggled with some form of drug addiction or alcoholism. Satan has veiled many from the truth of Jesus through addiction, broken families, poverty, entertainment, and the Occult.

Paul's words in Ephesians are such a helpful reminder: ¹² For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the powers, against the world forces of this darkness, against the spiritual forces of wickedness in the heavenly places.

Please pray for me, Scott, all the volunteers who give their time to share the love of Jesus with those in Prison. Pray for our protection from Devil and his schemes. Pray for God to continue to move by drawing more men and women into relationship with Himself!
